---

**Context-** Saint-Gobain's Innovative Materials sector develops industrial businesses to manufacture several types of materials, mainly glass, ceramics, abrasives and high performance plastics. It employs over 60.000 people spread over 570 sites in 47 countries. The sector also operates 6 R&D centers. Programs and an organizational structure are already in place to manage EHS risks.

In the field of industrial hygiene, the principal concerns are: toxic substances, noise, radiation, thermal constraints and biological agents.

**Mission-** within the aforementioned framework and reporting to the sector's EHS director, the Industrial Hygiene director will have to:

- Supervise the implementation of programs by sectors of activities and sites via the EHS networks and in liaison with management, including training, monitoring of indicators and audits where required;
- Assess the efficacy of current programs and participate to the definition of new ones;
- Provide scientific and technical assistance concerning special requests;
- Ensure scientific, technical and regulatory watch;
- Regularly exchange with the R&D centers;
- Teamwork with his or her Safety and Environment counterparts in the central team.

- Specific academic background in occupational industrial hygiene with a degree or major at engineer level (Bac+5 in the French system);
- Mandatory occupational certification recognized by the IOHA (International Occupational Hygiene Association);
- At least 10 years hands-on experience in industry;
- Author of scientific publications on industrial hygiene.
